

## Lesire Side table Assembly Instructions

In the box there is : An Octagonal top and 4 loose legs. Along with these parts is a small pack of 8 small screws and 4 small 'L' metal brackets.

### Step 1:

Remove all protective wrapping and place the top (with the top surface down) on a padded (blanket or cloth) surface to prevent scratching.

### Step 2:

Visually locate 4 fixing metal brackets on the top underside as shown in fig. 1

Take one leg and insert it into the bracket hole as shown in the figure below. Proceed to rotate the leg by hand in a clockwise direction thereby tightening the leg into the top, rotating it until it is tight as possible.

### Step 3:

With the leg in its tightest position, slightly adjust rotation in order to align the pre drilled hole on the leg with the pre drilled hole on the top. Remove 2 screws from the screw pack and fit one screw into the hole through the metal bracket hole onto the leg and another screw onto the top underside through the L bracket; to secure the leg in its final rotated position on the top and stop the leg from rotating in use. Tighten the screws using a manual screw driver.

Repeat the above processes for all 4 legs.

### Step 4:

When complete, turn the table over to stand it up being careful to stand it up on all 4 legs at the same time.

To maintain the Lesire table:

Do not sit on the table as it is not designed to sustain heavy weight above 20KG, especially non stationary weight.

Once or twice a year, or depending on usage, refinish the table with a good quality Danish oil by following instructions on the Danish oil. Pre sanding with a 400 Gritt sand paper to recreate the factory smooth finish is also recommended prior to applying the oil.

The Lesire table is for indoor use, or at least usage under shelter overhead. Avoid the table being exposed to direct sunlight and sudden changes in temperature as it is made from solid wood which is a natural material that contracts and expands due environmental changes.
